





Figure 1. On-Region Characteristics




Figure 2. Transfer Characteristics




Figure 3. On-Resistance Variation vs Drain Current and Gate Voltage




Figure 4. Body Diode Forward Voltage Variation with Source Current and Temperature




Figure 5. Capacitance Characteristics






Figure 6. Gate Charge Characteristics




**Figure 7. Vds Drain-Source Voltage vs Gate Voltage**




**Figure 8. On-Resistance vs Gate Voltage**



**Figure 9. Maximum Safe Operating Area**

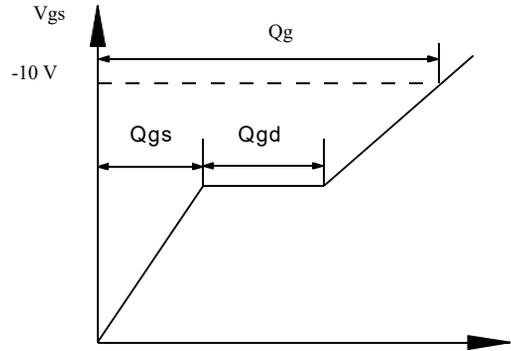



**Figure 10. Maximum Continuous Drain Current vs Temperature**





**Figure 11. Transient Thermal Response Curve**

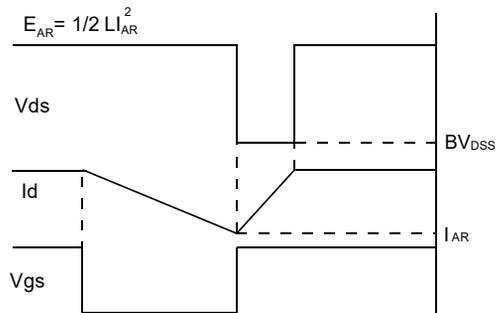
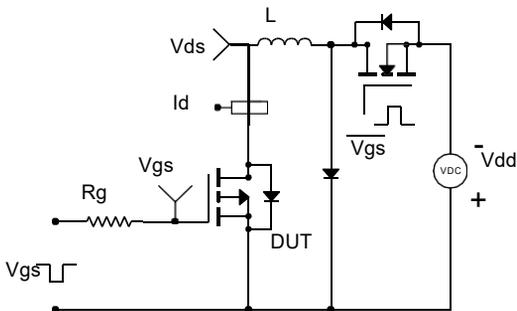
### Gate Charge Test Circuit & Waveform



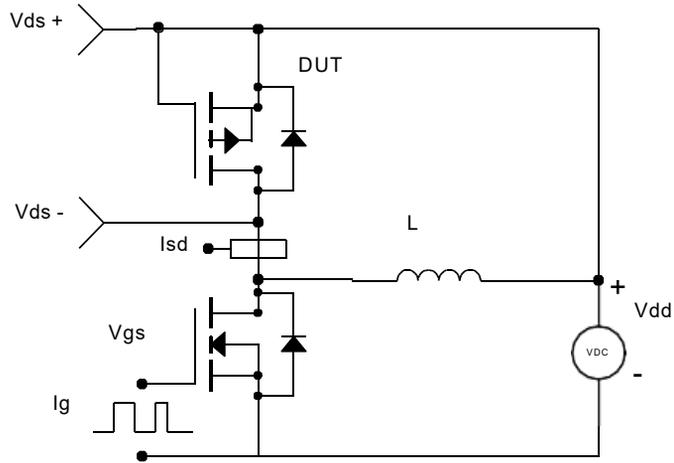
### Resistive Switching Test Circuit & Waveforms



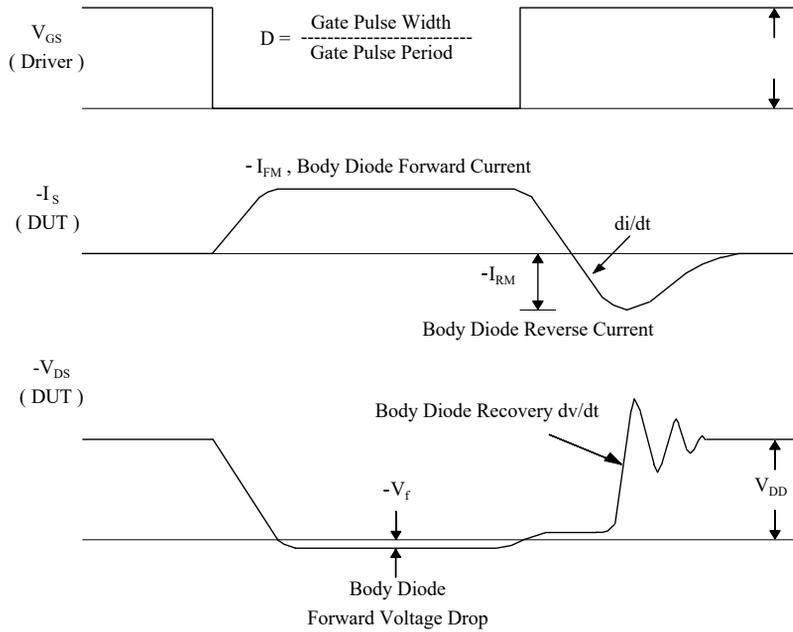
### Unclamped Inductive Switching Test Circuit & Waveforms






## Peak Diode Recovery dv/dt Test Circuit & Waveforms
